The Ray Hall Memorial Winter Track League is being established as a tribute to the contribution Ray Hall (Belgrave Harriers) gave to race walking. Ray competed in the 1962 European Games over 50km and was one of the few to beat 8 hours on the Stock Exchange London to Brighton. After hanging up his racing shoes he put an enormous amount back into athletics in many ways, particularly as a highly respected coach and race walk judge.

## Grangemouth - 15.07.23

Ireland were the only nation to fill all available slots in the 3000m walk. Held in front of a large crowd in dry, windy conditions, the Irish athletes dominated the race taking men's and women's gold and silver in both races. Matthew Newell (IRL) took the lead from the gun and narrowly missed the 24 year old CBP of 12:34.98 held by Lloyd Finch (ENG). There were personal bests for Ellis Simmonds (ENG) and Fraser Higginson (WAL) in third and fourth respectively.

Savannah O'Callaghan also took the lead from the start in the women's race and came home in a new personal best of 15:08.62s to claim gold. Bronze went to Lola-Mae Billingham (ENG) in a season's best of 16:53.22.

## **National Championships**

## UK Athletics Championships, Manchester (Sun. 9th July 2023)

**Women:** The track action on Sunday kicked off with, the women's 5000m walk which saw Heather Warner (Martin Bell, Pembrokeshire Harriers) put a huge lead in over reigning champion Bethan Davies (Andi Drake, Cardiff) to take the British crown in 2023. One of the three athletes to break away earlier in the race, Warner crossed the line in 22:22.50, a season's best, with Davies walking 22:55.85 also a season's best. Abigail Jennings (Verity Snook, Aldershot Farnham & District) produced a personal best of 24:11.68 for bronze.

Warner said: "It feels amazing to come back here and be British Champion again. I had a tough race last year with being disqualified, so it felt good to walk a good race today.

"The cards were shown quite early on, so it was a hard race to manage with being careful not to foul and achieving a good time. I would have loved to have pushed even more, but I had to play it tactically which I did."

Men: Chris Snook (Andi Drake, Aldershot Farnham & District) bettered the British silver he won last year with gold this time out, his time of 21:35.72 a winning margin of over 50 seconds ahead of Cameron Corbishley's (Andi Drake, Medway & Maidstone) 22:27.65 for silver. Luc Legon (Noel Carmody, Bexley) matched the bronze won in 2022 with a time of 22:54.91.

Post-race, Snook said: "I feel great – it's so nice to come to the British Championships, especially when you take the win. Domestically it is the biggest race there is, and it is good to see it on the programme here as it gives us some exposure."

Mark Culshaw (Land Registry) took an early lead with Steve Uttley (MoJ) and Martin Slevin (CCRC) close behind. After a couple of laps Steve had surged past Mark, Martin following him closely. Steve was never headed, coming home in 17:11.81. Martin was still close coming up to the bell, but had to concede, crossing the line around 27 seconds later. Mark was a further 44s behind.

Maureen Noel (MoD) and John Hall (Defra) formed a pairing in the middle of the race. Maureen was first woman home, making up some ground on Mark to finish in 19:11.57. John was always in touch but remained 15s back at the finish.

Jane Hodge (HMRC) and Geraldine Legon (Post Office) were in a third group at the rear of the field.
