Overseas

European Masters Athletic Championships, Pescara (ITA) (Thur. 21st Sept. to Sun. 1st Oct.)

Our British masters had a very successful European Masters Championships in Pescara, Italy picking up individual and team medals.

Most successful was Grazia Manzotti (W50) who won two gold (5000m and 20km) and a silver (10km). Maureen Noel (W60) picked up a gold (20km) and silver (10km), she did not contest the 5000m.

Noel Blatchford (W75) won silver in the 5000m, but sadly a few days later Noel became unwell and was hospitalised where it was discovered she had had a stroke. We wish her a speedy recovery.

Melanie Peddle (W55) finished just outside the medals in the 5000m but established a new British Age Group record of 27:24.36s. Melanie took bronze in the 20km.

On the men's side Ian Richards won M75 gold in the 5000m but suffered DQ's in the 10 and 20km. Peter Boszko won M70 silver over 5000m.

There were individual wins for Abigail Jennings (*pictured*) in the women's 20km with a personal best of 1:46.15. Hannah Hopper took the honours in the women's 10km with a season's best of 53:44.

Guy Thomas took second in the men's 20km, having reached 10km in 44:35, a painful hip hampered the second half of his race.

There was also a second place for junior Jessica Wilton in the 10km with 57:02.

Warm autumn sunshine made good for good conditions and with the likes of Melanie Peddle, Noel Blatchford and Grazina Manzotti vying for honours at the European Masters Championships in Italy, Hercocock Award recipients saving themselves for their big race next week and several still on holiday, it was a small field that faced the starter, **reports Ron Wallwork.**



Small field it might have been, but history was made when the first England Athletic Race Walk PB Awards were attained by young walkers Elin Wilson and Lily-Ann Cooper and RWA President Chris Hobbs was on hand to present them with their certificates. Three senior competitors also received certificates. It is hoped that this scheme will encourage other walkers especially young athletes in general, to try the discipline with this scheme providing a clear objective and pathway to improve.

Phil Barnard continued his comeback in good style winning easily, but as with most of the fixtures this season the hotly contested competition was at the head of the ladies race. On this occasion it was

With the second rail strike in two years on this race day and a number of regulars racing in Italy and Holland this was never going to be a big field, however ten on the line faced the starter's pistol.

The men's race was won by junior Jonny Ellerton with good style, in an excellent time slightly outside his personal best time at Coventry track this year. The Police Service UK and Civil Service Championships which included the Annual Ryan Cup Match went ahead on the established lap course in Cannon Hill Park, Birmingham despite the fears forecast by the Met Office of Storm Agnes, **reports Glyn Jones**. Thankfully for most of the race the weather remained dry apart from the very latter stages when heavy rain fell on the few remaining walkers out on the course.

Entries were not large by any standard but nevertheless the regular stalwarts and officials for this fixture were present to make it happen once again.

This year the PSUK won the Ryan Cup and maybe this was a fitting finale as the Police Sports Club from where this event has taken place being adjacent to the park, is being completely changed over into a Public Order Training facility and hence will no longer be a Sports Club building with facilities as has been previously enjoyed and thus a similar athletic fixture will probably no longer be possible.
