Chris Snook produced a personal best to take the men's 5000m win ahead of Cameron Corbishley who recorded a season's best as did Luc Legon who placed third. Abigail Jennings finished well clear of Pagen Spooner and Hannah Hopper who took second and third respectively in the senior women's race and Jess Wilton finished first U20 in a personal best.
